Announcing the Xstrahl 100 UK launch

Edinburgh Cancer Centre has become the first UK Radiotherapy department to purchase the Xstrahl 100 Superficial X-ray therapy machine, a dedicated low energy dermatological treatment unit.

Hamish Porter, Chief Physicist at the Edinburgh Cancer Centre said:

'Our first impression of the 100kV superficial unit was how neat and small it was. We intend using this unit exclusively for a skin therapy service and want the general impression of the equipment to be as patient friendly as possible. The patients we will be treating are mostly elderly and sometimes a bit scared and confused about what is happening to them and this unit fits our requirements ideally. The installation took only 2 days and went extremely well and commissioning began immediately after that. The staff involved have found it very straightforward to use; it is very manoeuvrable and very patient friendly'.
